

A Supportive Learning Environment at NPGPS for Non-Chinese Speaking (NCS) Students

At NPGPS, we strive to build an inclusive campus for all pupils, no matter which nationalities or ethnic groups they belong to. Although we follow a Chinese-based curriculum, i.e. all the subjects are taught in Chinese except English Language, NCS students receive extra support in learning to read and write Chinese, as well as speaking Cantonese, and build up friendships with other students at school.
