This story teaches us that you must be considerate and if you don't wish for something for yourself, never impose on others.

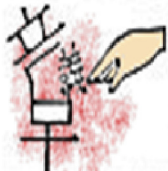

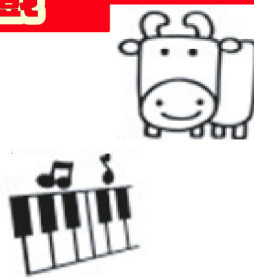
